TelVue To Launch Innovative Community Channel

New community channel will serve ten Camden County municipalities

TVTN allows local municipalities to enhance the content and presentation of their community channels by transforming text-based bulletin boards to multi-media outlets complete with full-motion video, graphics with voice over, as well as video-based public service announcements, local weather and traffic and instant emergency alerts.

"TVTN allows channel 19 to maximize the value of local programming by presenting reliable information and quality local content for many of the residents of Camden County."
