Pitman Access Channel Gets Extreme Makeover

Latest town to receive popular new service provided by TelVue Corporation

TVTN is a computer-based, cable access channel support network capable of upgrading the look, feel and functionality of thousands of access channels simultaneously. TVTN allows local municipalities to enhance the content and presentation of their community channels by transforming text-based bulletin boards to multi-media outlets complete with full-motion video, graphics with voice over, as well as video-based public service announcements, local weather, traffic and instant emergency alerts.

"We are very excited about the launch of TVTN in Pitman, New Jersey," said Joseph Murphy, TelVue Corporation's Executive Vice President. "Our access channel solution is gaining significant momentum. We are now hearing from small towns and large cities outside of New Jersey. Towns like Pitman are setting the tone for what could be a national trend."
